On Sunday, November 13, our church will hold a combined worship service at 11:00 a.m. as we celebrate the second year of our Sowing Seeds campaign for our building program. This will be a blended worship with special music from both the contemporary and traditional music leaders.

Prior to the worship service, I'm asking **all** Sunday school classes to meet at 9:45 a.m. As pastor I plan to visit as many of the children, youth, and adult classes as I can – which probably means just a couple of minutes in each class to allow time for me to get around to as many of the classes as possible.

The centerpiece of our building program is a new multi-purpose fellowship hall and kitchen that will be great for contemporary worship services, congregational covered-dish meals, Christmas plays, and other uses and events. The plan adopted two years ago also includes needed renovations to our beautiful sanctuary. This year the sanctuary was repainted, and carpeting is next on the list. The plan also includes an additional parking area.

All this is for God's glory and the promotion of the Gospel message in our community, as this building and renovations will greatly enhance the worship, fellowship, and mission outreach of the congregation. It is for the Lord.

The United Methodist Youth will be cooking potatoes with all the trimmings to be served after worship on November 13. Immediately after the potato lunch will be a cake auction to raise money for youth projects. {We need volunteers to bake/donate cakes and other desserts for the cake auction – thank you.}

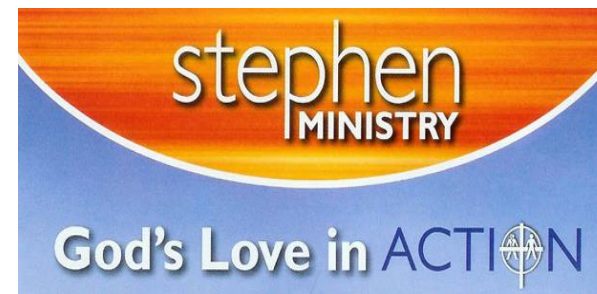
We take our lives for granted – as if it were our right, and not our gift.

ESTHER

The following is adapted from an email from Sheri Eschenfelder:

Wanted to update as many as I can of Esther's wonderful progress in her JOURNEY! Wednesday (*Oct 19*) surgery day was a long day. Can you believe Esther was 63 on the surgery schedule?! The staff let Esther know right away she was the princess for the day. Short version of her going to the OR is she had giggle juice then went happily watching Frozen in Spanish on the anesthesiologist's cell phone, grinning from ear to ear. The surgery was about five hours long but the OR staff gave hourly updates to Yami (*Esther's Mom*). (*Surgery went well.*) On the October 21 casts come off and she is measured for afos then a recast with a short cast. She will be able to stand at that point. The final visit to Vanderbilt is hopefully no later than December 5.

The goal is to have the afos within a week's time but typically it is two weeks. They fly out of Atlanta to Nicaragua on December 9.

The last thing I want to share is we plan to get the urodynamic test done after she gets the first casts off. This is expensive and NOT covered by International Aid Foundation. We estimate it to be about a thousand dollars. (*Will update later.*) We feel the many prayers said for Esther, Yami, and Danilo. Thank you, Sheri
